This presentation outlines a current project to revise IUCN's Enhancing our Heritage Toolkit (EoH) and discusses the implications of such collaborations with nature conservation bodies for cultural heritage researchers and practitioners. This project brings together specialists from various international agencies to develop an updated "EoH 2.0" to apply to all World Heritage sites, natural, cultural and "mixed". Cultural heritage specialists can usefully assist in such matters while at the same time learning valuable lessons from their natural heritage colleagues regarding monitoring and improving management effectiveness.
